CASTLE DALE CITY ZONING CLEARANCE AND APPROVAL PROCESS

If you live **INSIDE Castle Dale City boundary**, you must have proof of zoning compliance before the city can issue you a building permit. The city has the responsibility of issuing building permits and inspecting the buildings as they are built. The city has its own zoning ordinances and procedures for establishing zoning approval. A 'City Zoning Clearance and Approval' form must be filled out and signed before the city will issue a building permit. To obtain zoning approval, please submit the following information to Castle Dale City zoning administrator, Kerry Lake phone number 381-5229. If you have questions, call your city hall during their working hours.

- Location and size of structure on property
- Other structures, easements, etc., identified
