Emery County Recreation Co-Ed Softball Rules

1. Rules will be USSSA, unless stated otherwise.
2. **All teams must provide a signed roster and to the Recreation office after the second game. It is each team's responsibility to provide the roster. Each captains must sign a copy of the rules, before games start.**
3. Rosters will be limited to 15 players.
4. **PLAYERS MUST PARTICIPATE IN 4 GAMES TO BE ABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN TOURNAMENT AND MUST BE LISTED ON TEAM'S ROSTER. IF INJURED, DURING THE SEASON, PLAYERS CAN STILL PLAY IN TOURNAMENT, AS LONG AS YOU HAVE EITHER PLAYED OR WATCHED 4 REGULAR SEASON GAMES.**
5. Games are 55 minutes long. Games must begin on time.
6. A team may play with any number of players; however, nine batting slots must be filled. Unfilled slots up to nine will be automatic outs. Legal team members may fill empty slots at any time during the game. There is no minimum number of players required to start a game.
7. Every attempt will be made to notify teams when games are cancelled due to weather. However, decisions sometimes cannot be made until just before game time. It is the team's responsibility to contact Recreation when weather threatens 435-381-3505.
8. **No alcohol or drugs will be permitted nor tolerated on the playing field or on the player benches. NO WARNINGS WILL BE GIVEN.** Failure to comply will result in immediate forfeiture of the game. A second incident will result in the team being disqualified from the present game and the next game the team is scheduled to play. A third incident will result in the team being disqualified from the remainder of the league and the post season tournaments.
9. **If any player is ejected for any reason they will be suspended for the remainder of the game and will be charged a \$10 fine which they must pay before they are allowed to play again. If they are ejected a 2nd time they are assessed a \$25 fine and they are banned from any other ECR programs until they have appeared before the Director of Emery County Recreation. The fines that are collected go into a low income fund for children who cannot afford to pay for programs.**
10. **Vulgar or abusive language will not be tolerated.** Consider this as your first warning!! Public profanity is a crime. The perpetrator will be ejected from the game. (See rule #8) Anyone other than players using such language will be asked to leave. This rule applies to players involved in games and anyone else at the softball field. This rule will be enforced by umpires, the league director, and Recreation staff.
11. **Fighting will not be tolerated.** Throwing a punch, or any other fighting will result in the perpetrator being barred from further play for the season. Reinstatement can only be made by the Emery County Recreation Board of Directors.
12. Only players and coaches are permitted in the vicinity of the bench.
13. **Games will be 7 innings or 55 minutes, whichever comes first. No new inning will begin after 55 minutes.**
14. **A game will be called when one team is leading by 20 runs after 3 innings, 15 runs after 4 innings, or 10 runs after 5 innings.**
15. **Metal cleats are not allowed.** Any player wearing metal cleats will be ejected from that game and serve a one game suspension.
16. **HOME RUNS:** One team can only have two more home runs than the other team, with no limit. A home run is a ball that leaves the field in flight, in fair territory and is unassisted by any player. All others are outs.
17. Players must play only for the team whose roster they have signed. However, if they choose to play for a different team it is up to the captain of that team to clear the illegal player with the opposing team. If the opposing team has no objections a protest **cannot** be filed at any time. If the team fails to clear the illegal player the opposing team can protest the roster violation. A protest must be filed by the inning following the entrance of the illegal player into the scorebook. Protests must be made with the umpire and written in the official scorers book to be valid. At the time of the protest the game is over.
18. TieBreakers: 1) Head to head; 2) Coin Toss
19. **Teams must play with at least an equal number of men and women.** A team may have more women than men. You must have at least two women in the infield and at least two women in the outfield. If the pitcher is a woman, the catcher must be a man and vice versa.
20. Batting order must alternate man, woman or vice versa. Two women may bat back to back. If a man walks when he is up to bat, the woman who is next up to bat has the option to also walk, or she may choose to hit. The man gets to advance to 2nd base no matter if the woman chooses to walk or hit.

21. **Men must stay behind the designated cones until the ball has been hit when a woman is up to bat. Men in the infield must have both feet on the infield dirt until the ball has been hit when a woman is up to bat.** Failure to comply will result in all base runners, including the batter, being awarded two bases.
22. **Only USSSA approved bats may be used in this league. If your bat is illegal do not use it. The team captains will have to make a protest of an illegal bat at the time that the bat is discovered or thought to be illegal. The protest must also be made before the game ends. Once a game ends no protests of any kind can be filed.**
